Location

- Start: 9:30 am, **Melbourne.**
- Finish: Transfer to Bairnsdale from your last night's stay at beautiful Marlo. At Bairnsdale there are various transport options for train return to Melbourne or to continue your journey.
 - Train takes 4 hours to return to Melbourne Southern cross.
 - Train fares or other travel expenses are at own expense.
